

Due to the competitive spirit, camaraderie, and generosity demonstrated in 2023, we were able to hit our largest target for breast cancer research! Clays for the Cure 2023 raised \$131,000, thanks to you! Scheduled to participate this year is Hall of Famer Class of 2021 inductee Alan Faneca.

Clays impact on breast cancer treatment across the country is amazing. Researchers were able to receive a \$3 million grant from the National Institutes of Health from seed funding GOH provided from the Clay's event.
